A conversation could change a life.

R U OK Day is a national day of action dedicated to reminding everyone that any day is the perfect day to ask, "Are you ok?" This year the day was held on 12 September 2018.

The R U OK? Organization believes that we all have what it takes to help make a difference in the life of another person.

R U OK? recommends 4-steps to engage and support someone for whom you have some concerns:

1. **Ask**
2. **Listen**
3. **Encourage action**
4. **Check in**

By starting the conversation and commenting on changes you've noticed, such as:

- o They're not joining in the activities they used to enjoy
- o They seem to have trouble getting out of bed
- o They seem happier or sadder than usual
- o They're not eating
- o They're drinking too much
- o They're not going to work

You may just help someone you know to open up and get the help they need.

So, as another R U OK? Day has come and gone, Winun Ngari encourages everyone to notice the behaviours of friends, family and work colleagues. And if you notice a change, find the time to ask, listen, encourage action and check in. People knowing others care and have noticed they may not be doing so well, can make all the difference to them.
